Best Practices Implementation

To help you implement LLLC Driver Certification, we've broken out best practices for onboarding new drivers and experienced drivers. Use the Learning Management System to schedule the six A-Fleet self-directed online modules each week or every other week to complete the certification process while reinforcing the defensive driving behaviors over time.

For Onboarding New Drivers:

Take advantage of the face-to-face time during orientation by implementing the classroom workshop and Behind-The-Wheel evaluation. Then, assign your new driver the six Self-Directed Courses to complete on their own time and earn their Certification.

For Experienced Drivers:

Incorporate the six Self-Directed Courses into your existing monthly training curriculum. Upon completion of the courses, have the drivers schedule invididual or group (no more than three at a time) Classroom Workshop and Behind-The-Wheel evaluation.
